## Maui – Rejoice in Nature

Continuously voted ‘the best island in the world’ by prestigious travel magazines, Maui offers picture-postcard scenery at every turn, a range of diverse experiences and numerous first-class resorts.

Day 1	It seems Maui was made for lovers. It’s the perfect backdrop for your dream wedding - from a barefoot gathering on the sand to a formal celebration in an elegant resort.
Day 2	Take a morning snorkel off Ka’anapali Beach and look for green sea turtles! Then head for Lāhainā to explore the many galleries and historic sites. Discover Hawaiian culture at its best this evening at the Old Lahaina Lū’au.
Day 3	Take an early morning tour to the top of the dormant volcano Haleakalā to watch a breathtaking sunrise.
Day 4	Head down to the Mā’alaea Harbour for a morning picnic snorkel cruise to the underwater paradise of Molokini Crater. Then take a drive along the beautiful south coast to Wailea, a luxurious resort community known for crescent-shaped beaches.
Day 5	With more than 600 hairpin turns and 54 narrow bridges, the famous Road to Hāna showcases some of the most scenic landscapes on Maui. From plunging seaside cliffs and magnificent waterfalls to the flavours of fresh island fruit from a roadside stand, this is a journey to awaken the senses.
Day 6	South Maui is renowned for its fine weather and visiting humpback whales (Dec - Apr) and is also home to outstanding boutiques, restaurants and golf courses. Afterwards, enjoy a relaxing massage for two by the sea.

## Kaua’i – Take a Heavenly Escape

Kaua’i, the least populated of Hawai’i’s four main islands, is the ideal ‘quiet escape’. Appropriately named ‘The Garden Isle’, it’s an island of immense natural beauty with rainforest-covered cliffs, cascading waterfalls and sapphire waters.

Day 1	Say your vows in a magical botanic garden, barefoot on the sands, in a historic church, or on a private estate. The beautiful “Hawaiian Wedding Song” made famous by Elvis in the movie “Blue Hawaii” (filmed on Kaua’i) is often sung.
Day 2	Celebrate your first day as newlyweds in the majestic Waimea Canyon - the Grand Canyon of the Pacific and one of Kaua’i’s biggest attractions. This massive canyon provides stunning views, with numerous lookouts and hiking trails.
Day 3	Spend the day walking along the golden shores of Po’ipū Beach, one of the best swimming beaches in all of Hawai’i. Stay until late to watch an unforgettable sunset.
Day 4	The majestic 25km NāPali (‘the cliffs’) Coast in the northwest is a ‘must-see’ and is accessible only by air, boat and on foot. For a truly amazing perspective, take to the air by helicopter.
Day 5	Rejuvenate with an irresistible spa treatment incorporating fragrant natural ingredients and an Hawaiian lomilomi massage using flowing, rhythmic strokes.
Day 6	Kaua’i – with a dramatic backdrop of towering mountains and cascading waterfalls - has been featured in more than 60 TV shows and movies. Take a romantic drive to famous locations and create some picture-perfect moments.

## Big Island – Worship the Big Outdoors

The Big Island of Hawai’i encompasses all but two of the world’s climatic zones, offering everything from lush rainforest to volcanic desert, snow-capped mountains and beautiful black-sand beaches. It is the perfect romantic getaway for those wanting a close encounter with nature.

Day 1	Say your vows beside a cascading waterfall, in a seaside chapel or at a popular ceremonial site. Hawai’i’s Big Island offers a diverse range of perfect settings.
